Della called the meeting to order at 1:10 pm. Announcements

• Della Swaim announced that TRTA has cancelled all in person meetings until July. She shared the upcoming important dates:

February 17, next Zoom meeting, April 21 Zoom meeting, and May 19 is the final Zoom member meeting, which will be the installation of the new officers. Also, the Day at the Capital will be April 6-8. No date has been set by the district for new spring officer training.

- Kay Edmondson reminded members they can still send her their volunteer hours for 2020.
- Lori Smith & Lori McCall reported on Membership/luncheons and are planning a possible summer luncheon in July.
- Mary Eisenmann discussed the February 20 Retirement Seminar will be held on Zoom.
