Be Prepared for the ER

The hospital emergency room deals effectively with sudden health problems; however, you and your family must be equipped, informed, and prepared to participate actively in your own care to make sure that you have a positive outcome.

Create a cheat sheet in triplicate (ER, ambulance, and yourself) with current medications, dosages, and dispense times. Include known allergies, insurance information, family contacts, power of attorney, and specialty doctors. Be prepared to speak up if the caregivers seem to be going in a different direction from what you know about yourself or your loved one. Go with patience. Stay calm. Leave your valuables at home.


