





The State of Texas likes to know how many hours retired school personnel give back to the community. Hours are counted from January 1 to December 31, 2017. Keep track of your volunteer hours and report them monthly or in a lump sum at the end of the year.

Count obvious things such as volunteering as a school mentor as well as counting hours spent babysitting grandchildren and care-taking ill family members; even count the hours driving to and from such tasks.
